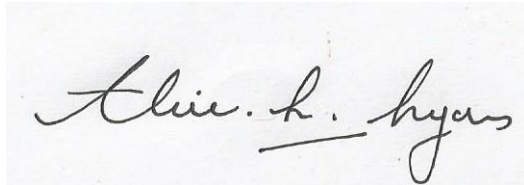

In 2024 no journal was published with the next one due to be published in 2026.</li> <li>• Funds projects supporting the appreciation and greater understanding of ceramics and Roman pottery in Britain and Europe.</li> </ul> |

| <b>Financial review</b>   | <p>Also refer to the SOFA and Balance Sheet copied below.</p> <p>Income for the year was £4,147 (2023: £4,525) which was mainly made up of membership subscriptions (£2,726) and income from the 2024 conference (£1,246). A further £175 of income was mainly from bank interest with a small amount of donation income.</p> <p>Expenditure for the year was £1,889 (2023: £9,719) with £1,314 spent on the St. Albans conference and £500 spent on the Journal of Roman Pottery Studies volume 20. Finally £75 was awarded as part of the John Gillam prize.</p> <p>Reserves totalled £13,062 at the end of 2024 (2023: £10,804) which were all unrestricted and represented balances held in the 2 charity bank accounts. The slight increase in reserves follows several years of decreasing reserves and these funds will be partially used to publish volume 21 of the Journal.</p> |
